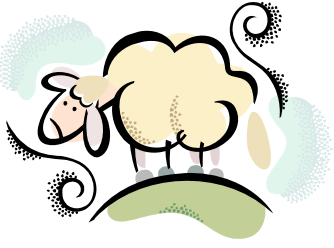
The sand boxes are the most popular these days since we have new toys!!! After settling back down from being outside it is time to get down to business.

### BIBLE DISCUSSION GROUP

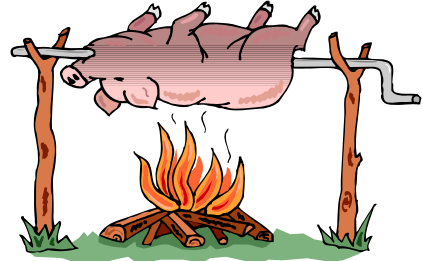
